

FibroScan Instruction

Your provider has ordered a FibroScan, also known as an Elastogram. Examination with FibroScan is a non-invasive, painless way to measure the stiffness of your liver. FibroScan works by emitting a small pulse of energy, which may feel as a slight vibration on your skin.

It is important to tell your healthcare providers if you are pregnant, or if you have any active implantable electronic devices, such as pacemakers, defibrillators, or pumps. FibroScan should not be used if you are pregnant or have any implantable electronic devices.

Instructions:

1. Nothing to eat or drink **3 hours prior to your exam** (*including water*).
2. Wear comfortable clothes that will allow your healthcare provider to expose the right side of your rib cage.
